


This exclusive, FREE web application developed by CCCTMA's acclaimed, in-house mapping and technology experts, works with built-in GPS capabilities on iPhone and Android-enabled devices. With a mere touch of your finger, it can show all known existing bikeways in your immediate area, conveniently displayed on an interactive Google map. Bike Route Locator can also be viewed with web browsers on desktop computers and other mobile devices.

The app includes over 400+ bikeway segments in: Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester and Salem counties. Selecting an individual bikeway reveals information such as the route name, type of facility, length, and location. The Bike Locator App can even tell you what TYPE of bikeway from which one may choose: an off-road path, on-road bicycle lane, a shared bicycle route, or a NJ DOT bicycle touring route. There are numerous touring routes statewide, including the 238-mile *High Point to Cape May Route*, as well as the newly released *Explore the Jersey Shore by Bicycle Routes!*

What's more, Google Streetview is also featured within the application. Simply drag their little yellow person icon onto the roadway you would like to see, and it will open a panoramic view of the bikeway that you can then pan and zoom. This invaluable feature allows you to familiarize yourself with the specific conditions and visual location of each route before you head out the door.
