

## Transit Locator App now covers entire state of New Jersey

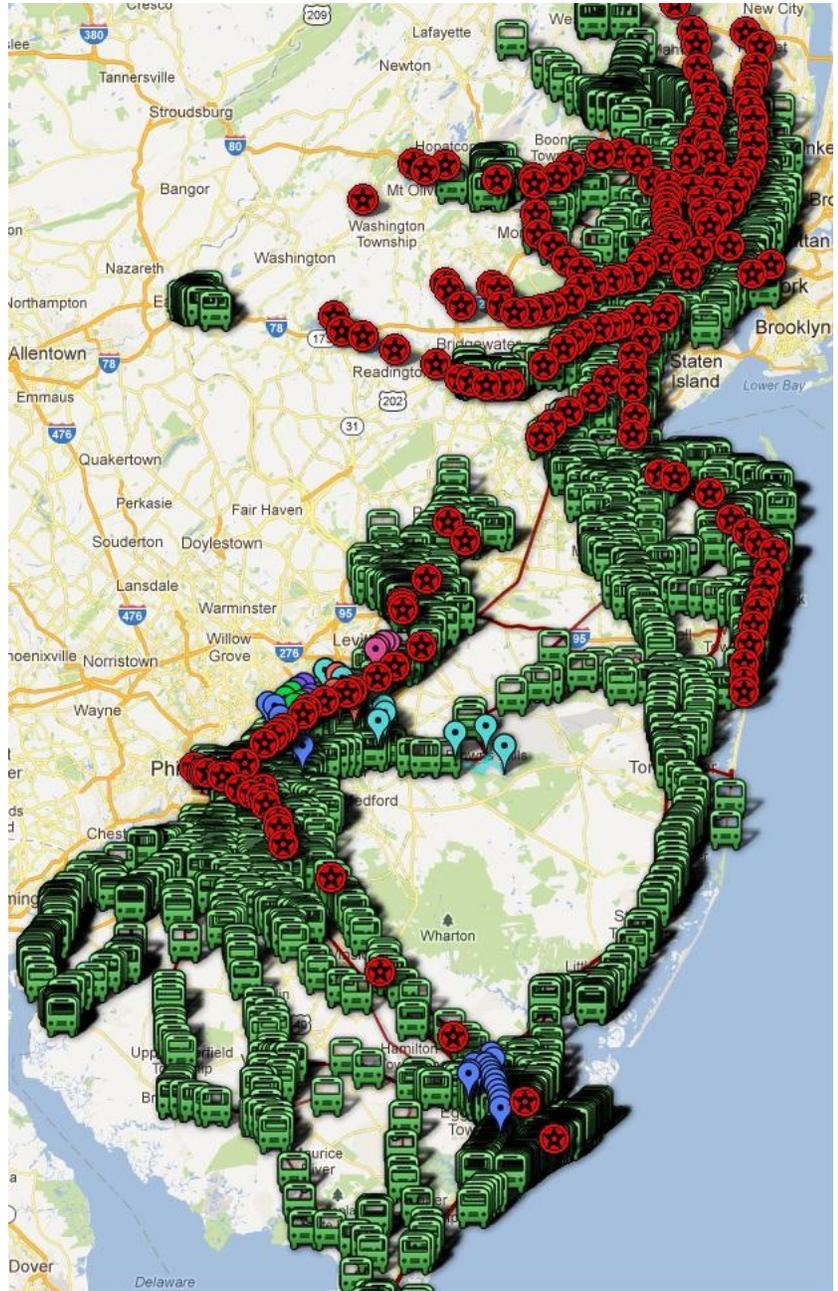
Cross County Connection is proud to announce that the Transit Locator App has been expanded to provide transit information for the entire state of New Jersey. The app now includes all NJ TRANSIT statewide bus and rail systems, PATCO Speedline, and several county shuttle routes. Transit Locator allows users to access all of this transit information at the tip of your fingers!

### Transit Locator Features:

- Displays the nearest public transportation based on your current location
- Identifies NJ TRANSIT bus stops by ID#
- Receive text message updates telling you when the next NJ TRANSIT bus will arrive
- Includes links to bus and rail timetables to view on your mobile device
- FREE and easy to use!

### Includes the following transit services:

- 260+ NJ TRANSIT statewide bus routes with schedule link
- 30,000+ NJ TRANSIT statewide bus stops with MyBus ID
- 190+ NJ TRANSIT and PATCO rail stations with timetable link
- English Creek Community Shuttle route and stops
- Updated BurLink stops and routes

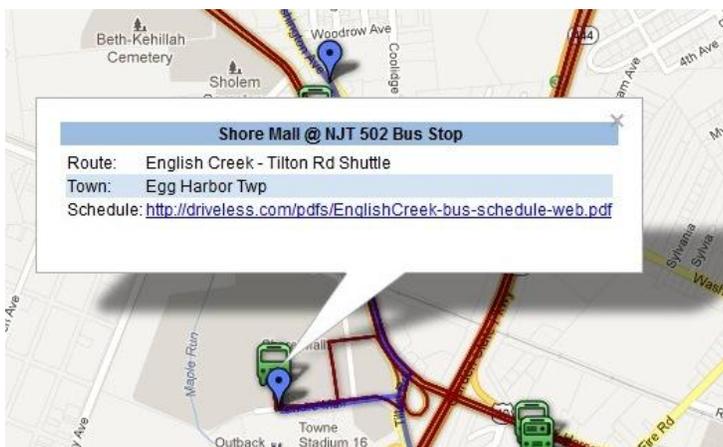
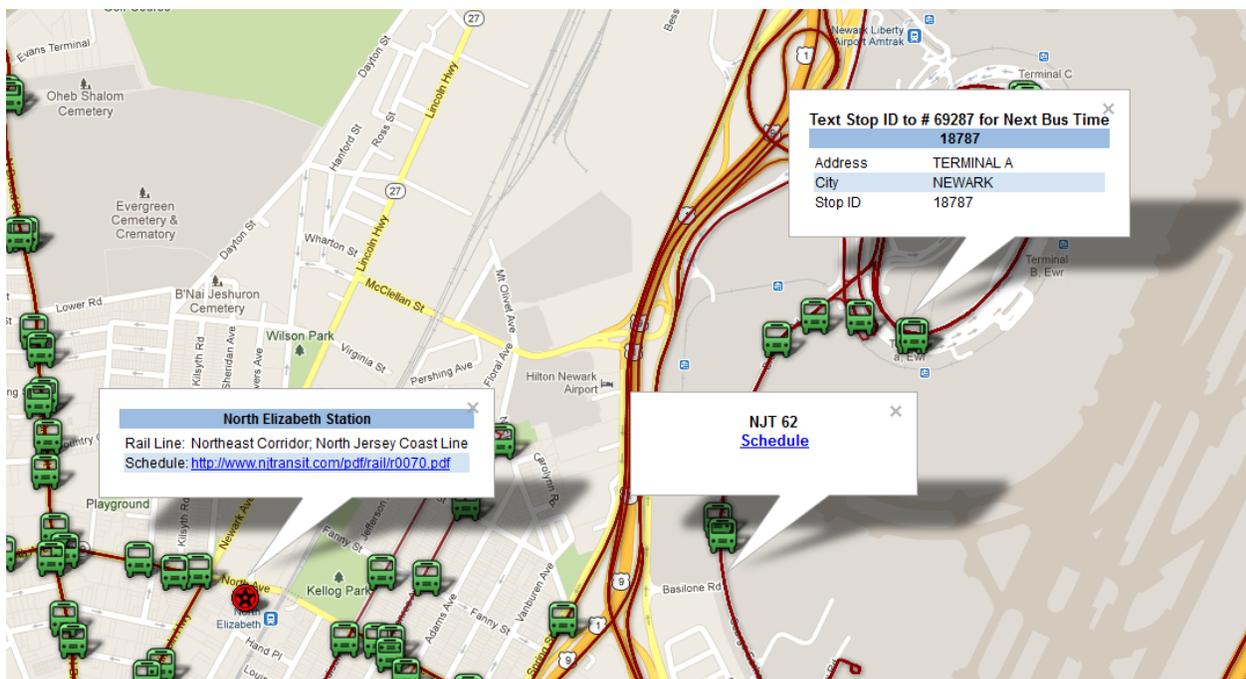


Transit Locator is a web application that Cross County Connection developed in-house to identify the nearest public transportation using the built-in GPS capabilities of your iPhone or Android device. You are encouraged to try out the App now on your phone as we walk you through some of the embedded features.

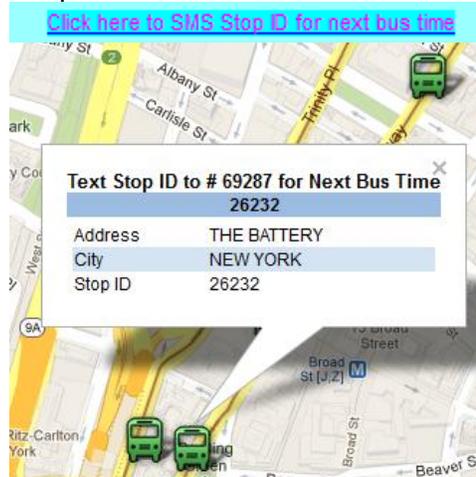


### Try it Now!

- 1) Use your iPhone or Android device to scan the QR code and activate the app.
- 2) Once the link is opened in your phone's browser it will ask you to "Share Your Location". By selecting "Yes" it reads the internal GPS signal from your phone and displays a map with your location.
- 3) If using an iPhone, you have the ability to save the App with an icon on your home screen. Android device users can bookmark the url ([www.transitlocator.com](http://www.transitlocator.com)) in order to quickly access the App as needed.
- 4) After the App finds your location it will display the public transportation routes and stops in your vicinity. You can then select the icons on the map to obtain the bus stop ID, bus route number, or rail station name and download the appropriate PDF schedule.



- 5) Transit Locator also incorporates the NJ TRANSIT “MyBus” service into the web application so that you can obtain information about when the next bus is expected to arrive. To use this service, select the link on the blue bar across the top of the screen which will open a self-addressed text message box. Then enter the Stop ID# shown and hit ‘Send’. Within seconds you will receive a return message that displays the times when the next bus is expected at that location.



- 6) Google’s Streetview service is also included in the Transit Locator Application. To access this feature, pick up the yellow human icon on the left of the screen and drop it onto the map in the desired location. This will change the map view to the Streetview service, allowing you to familiarize yourself with any location remotely before visiting in person.



Commuters and travelers are encouraged to use Transit Locator anywhere in New Jersey. You just never know what transit services are available at a given location, so give the Transit Locator a try!
